



Students-Evaluations in MedHub

There are a couple different ways to access evaluations in MedHub

1. Click on the Urgent Tasks box



OR...

2. Click on the Evaluations tab



Assuming that you have pending evaluations they will be listed under the incomplete evaluations.

1. Click on the evaluation to open it

Note: Some clerkships use a method called Student Identifies supervisor to distribute evaluations. If you need to do this these items will be above Evaluation Requests.

Example:

Eskenzaiz-OR	2/14-2/24/2017	2/18/2017	0 (3)	Incomplete

Many other clerkships will schedule your evaluations and you will receive an email notification that you have an evaluation to complete.

Once you are inside an evaluation you will see that the evaluator, evaluatee, clerkship/course, and issue date are identified at the top.

The kind of answer types you might see are..

1. Scale
2. Multiple Choice
3. Short Answer
4. Etc.

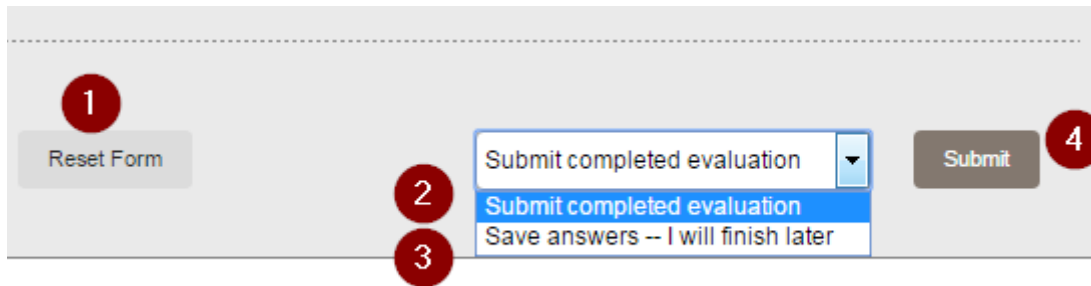
